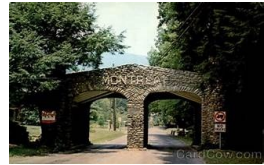

SESSION MEETING NOTES

MARCH 20, 2018

David Hosick presented an overview of the PneuMatrix program, dealing with adaptive change within the church and his responsibilities as the PneuMatrix coach to the SPC team over the next 12 months. The program begins in April.

Debra Haddock (from Farmville Presbyterian Church, Farmville, NC) and Fred and Ann Timm (from St. Paul Lutheran Church, Westerville, OH) were presented and examined for church membership. Debra is sponsored by Mabel Lacey and the Timms are sponsored by Larry and Carol Hibschman. A vote was taken and approval given.

Doug Boyette reported the following transfer request: Debra Griffin to Wesley Memorial United Methodist Church in High Point, NC. The request was approved. Luke Harkey informed Session of his upcoming trip to Israel. In his absence, Len Byers will preach on April 29 and Joan Martin on May 6. Neighborhood groups should be aware to address congregational pastoral needs during this time.

Luke also reported that the Cleveland County Rescue Mission Banquet had an excellent attendance.

Luke reported that Kevin Walker, a frequent guest at the SPC soup kitchen and homeless, had been accepted at a shelter in Hendersonville. The hope is that Kevin will be able to improve his health and personal life at the shelter. (Kevin is now back in Shelby.)

Brock Taylor reported that communion would be served by intinction on Maundy Thursday, by intinction at the 8:30 a.m. Service on Easter, and served by Elders at the 11:00 a.m. Service on Easter.

Jill Venable reported on the following items:
•\$1000.00 from the LeGrand Fund was approved to aid in repairing fire damage at the Tenwek Hospital.
•\$1000.00 from the Member Care Fund for the Water to Wine Grant. Both were approved by Session.
•\$500.00 was given to sponsor a table at the CCRM Banquet.
•\$1500.00 from the Bonnie Sanford Playground Fund was provided to assist with the cost of the new playground fence. Also, a toy chest or cabinet in honor of Bonnie is in the works. This was approved by Session.

The Scholarship Challenge has pledged \$12,246.00 out of \$29,000.00. Other monies are expected including \$5000.00 from the Jones Youth Fund.

Margie McSwain sent a report that a Special Communion Service for homebound members and others who are not able to attend church regularly will be held on April 15 at 2:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary with Luke presiding. Refreshments and fellowship will follow in Ellis Hall.

The Security and Safety Task Force will meet on the second Tuesday of every month. Doug Boyette is in contact with Phillips about repairing and replacement parts for the church's defibrillators.

Betsy Fonvielle (Spiritual Life Committee) reported the start of a four week small group study on prayer. The study begins April 22nd and runs from 6 to 7 p.m.

Jeanne Spragins made the recommendation from Worship & Music Committee that the organ console positions be switched and the floor on the organ side be leveled to accommodate a grand piano. Also, the committee discussed purchasing a grand piano. A question was asked about moving the light switches from left to right and was referred back to the committee.
