Dear Members and Friends:

Happy New Year! As you may know, January gets its name from Greek mythology. Janus is depicted with two faces: one looking back and one looking forward. As Christians we too are two-faced, in the best sense of the word! This is a most appropriate time to thank God for the blessings of days past, and to ask God's guidance for the days ahead. One thing is certain: God's love for us is a constant in a world where everything seems to be constantly changing. Two verses come to mind: Hebrews 13.5: "I will never leave you or forsake you" and Hebrews 13.8 that declares: "Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

Change can be unsettling, but can also be an opportunity to discover in fresh and exciting ways the future that God has in store for us, as people and as a church. On Saturday January 12th our officers, elders and deacons, will meet for their annual planning retreat. This year the retreat marks the beginning of a mission study – a process that involves discerning what the next chapter holds in store for our congregation. As Presbyterians we place strong emphasis on what God is calling us to be and to do as a covenant people guided by the Holy Spirit. During officer training we talked about the motto that helps explain our Reformed theological heritage: "reformed, and always being reformed, according to the Word of God."

One of the resources that will assist our officers has been called Pneumatrix. Several of you have asked about this since seeking a passing reference in the December church newsletter. Actually, Pneumatrix is the name of a church consulting group that has been working with eleven congregations in our presbytery, the Presbytery of

Western North Carolina. Shelby Presbyterian is one of those ten congregations. Last summer our Session established a task force that included Jeff Hamilton, chair, Ben Brooks, Betsy Fonvielle, Joe Ogburn, Kathy Wilson, and me, Luke Harkey. The Rev. David Hosick from Tryon, NC served as a "coach" for us and Deborah Wright, served as our chief consultant. The chief resource that guided this process was a book entitled "Canoeing the Mountains" by Todd Bolinger.

Todd Bolinger uses the experience of the Lewis and Clark expedition in early U.S. history as a metaphor for the challenges facing the Christian church today. The author tells how this expedition expected to paddle in their canoes all the way to the Pacific ocean. They were not prepared to cross the Rocky Mountains any more than most churches our day are prepared to encounter the culture that has changed around us.

Here is a quote from the book about the challenges we face in our day: "Please pray for our congregation and especially for our officers as they themselves pray for wisdom and ask God to guide us in the days ahead."

Earlier in this letter I mentioned two verses from Hebrews 13. I would like to conclude with one more passage from this chapter (Hebrews 13.20-21): "Now may the God of peace, who brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, make you complete in everything good so that you may do his will, working among us that which is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen."
