DONUT TIME

The Coffee Hour, sometimes referred to as "Donut Time," is a longstanding tradition at Shelby Presbyterian. Each Sunday morning during the school year, one of us turns on the lights in the kitchen at 8:30 and proceeds to brew two kinds of coffee and turns on the oven to heat donuts and bagels. Some donuts are cut in half before being placed on the baking sheet. Bagels are cut into smaller portions as well. Sugar, sweetener, cream, stir sticks, pitchers of water and orange juice along with cups and napkins are assembled for the service cart in the fellowship hall. At around 9:20, donuts and bagels are put in the oven to warm before being served at approximately 9:30. Everything needed is in the kitchen and ready. The host/hostess greets members and replenishes as needed. It is one of the many ways we welcome members, guests and visitors and extend the hospitality of the church. Clean-up is easy and takes little time.

Two regular volunteers cannot continue. Remaining volunteers have juggled schedules so that all Sundays have been covered. The best team would be one person or couple for each Sunday and a fifth person who could substitute/fill in as needed. If you have the gift of hospitality and would be willing to become a coffee hour volunteer, please let Miranda know. If you would like to come some Sunday morning and see what it's all about, just show up!

This is a great way to be of service with a relatively small time commitment. Please consider.

Dear Friends in Christ,

I have an update for you on our search for a new pastor. The first step has been to develop a mission/vision statement for SPC that will be submitted to the Presbytery of Western North Carolina Leadership Council and the Committee on Ministry for consideration and hopefully approval. The mission statement has been composed by SPC church officers with plans to present a final draft to Session for approval on April 28. After Session approval, the statement can then be forwarded to Presbytery.

Once Presbytery approves the Mission Statement, we will begin forming a Pastoral Nominating Committee. The hope is to have this group put together by late summer. If you are asked to serve, please give prayerful consideration to working on this committee as it will help to begin a new chapter in our church's history.

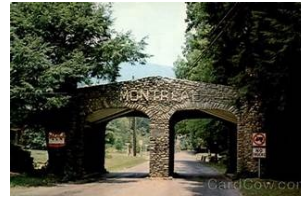
