Steve is a Gastroenterologist (digestive disease specialist) and served as the Director of Endoscopy Services at Tenwek Hospital until he was asked to begin service as the Medical Superintendent for the 365-bed Tenwek Hospital with physician training programs for 20 Interns and 21 Residents.
