Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Coming back from Montreat, I am amazed at this church. It's one thing for a group of 150 people to gather on Sunday. It's quite a different thing for those individuals and families to **spend a weekend together!**

This is not the work of a pastor or staff. No, **it is a sign of a deep connection and interest among people of different backgrounds and experiences. This is what the church is all about - Bringing people together in the love of our God.**

Now, I realize not everyone came out to Montreat, but we see the same connection and interest in the conversations in the pews and on our lawn after Sunday services. We see it in the phone calls, cards, and letters shared among members of our church, especially in our neighborhood groups. We see it in the ways you make sure those who cannot come on Sunday, still feel included and a part of the church. It's visible in Wednesday Night Suppers, events like Heritage Sunday, and friendships at every level.

The interconnectedness of this church is visible too in the way you reach into the community - to those who are not a part of this church, simply to share the love of God with those outside our church community as well.

This was the big theme of the Montreat weekend - Each of us is a piece of the larger puzzle that is Shelby Presbyterian Church. Each of you has something special to offer that makes you unique, and it is part of the church as a whole. And what's more, **you are not bound by the traditionalism that can constrain new ideas, but you are free in the tradition of the church that carries the living faith of a great cloud of witnesses forward into the modern culture by sharing God's love.**

Over that weekend, we discussed the movie Moana, in which the title character struggles with her yearning for the sea, versus the traditionalism of her island. Life is perfect on the island. Everyone there has all they need. She will even be chief someday, but her true identity is found in the history of her people.

Sisters and brothers, the history of our faith is the good news that God desires unity, for people who are divided to be one again by the faithfulness of God in Jesus and our allegiance to him. **Yes, the good news is that God came down to be one of us. In Jesus, the division between God and humanity ended. Now God is with us in the Holy Spirit. We are temples, not a building. Our calling then is to reconcile with one another as God is reconciled with us.**

As we continue to grow as a church, let us recall that God calls us always in new ways to carry out our historic calling to bring love and reconciliation into the world as Christ's hands and feet. You are the church. Your piece is special. Your piece with everyone else's reveals the beauty and love of our God. - Drew



# SPC Reports & Minutes

## SESSION MINUTES AUGUST 22, 2023

### Communications

**Clerk's Report** - John Schweppe reported: We continue our search for a covered shelter for the church van.

**Deacon's Report** - Elizabeth Schweppe reported: Patrick Glenn has solved all the technical issues with livestream.

• The August Blood Drive was a success. We surpassed our goal and collected 48 units and reminded that the next Blood Drive is October 17th.

• Wednesday Night Fellowship resumes September 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Pastor's Report** - Drew reported: Ryburn will receive \$2,000.00 per month for the next five months from Presbytery.

• A new member class will begin in October.

• Presbytery met online with nothing to report that affects Shelby Presbyterian Church.

• The next Presbytery meeting will be October 24<sup>th</sup> in Gastonia.

**Online Votes & Minutes:** Minutes for the July 25<sup>th</sup> Session Meeting were approved unanimously following motion by Bill Jobe, seconded by Larry Wilson.

### Committee Reports:

Discipleship Committee - Steve Sisk reported: 144 members of adults and children will attend the Montreat Churchwide Retreat with one room remaining with twin beds.

Finance Committee - Scoot Dixon reported: The church finances continue steady. Collections are ahead for July and have not needed any carryover to sustain the budget.

• In excess of \$25,000.00 has been raised for the Habitat Building Project.

• Kitchen Committee proposal is being updated. Roger Holland is securing revised estimates.

Property Committee - Fred Blackley reported: Regarding the community refrigerator, the Property Committee is of the opinion that a location outside the church building beside Drew's office will be the most appropriate location, although no final decision has been made.

Worship & Music - Richard Dedmon reported: Dan McLaurin will preach September 17th.

• Baptism of Lena Kate and Vivian Dow approved with a second since being a recommendation from the committee requires only a second by Larry Wilson and unanimous approval.

• Communion by intinction will occur on September 3rd.

Mission & Ministry Committee - Larry Wilson reported: 35-40 meals are being served weekly which with the growth may require opening another section of the Fellowship Hall.

Fellowship Committee - Kimberly Dixon reported: September 6<sup>th</sup> will be the first Fall Wednesday night supper featuring a Taco Bar.

• October 8<sup>th</sup>, the church picnic will be held at the Wilson's home.

• November 1<sup>st</sup>, Wednesday night program's subject will be Spiritual Gifts.
