Our soul is who we are, and loving God with all our soul means sharing who we are with God and one another.

**Engage your** <u>strength</u> by contributing your talents, be it with the Habitat house, or any of our church committees. God has given each of us talents and strengths, which can be amplified in service to Christ's church. Volunteers are always needed, and we want your voice and your gifts leading this church.

At different stages of life, one or another may take the lead, or be all we can do. But this summer, I pray you find your opportunity to grow in your walk with Jesus through the life of His church here at Shelby Presbyterian.


