Keep your eye out for a letter asking you for your best gift, which will be matched dollar-for-dollar to raise \$100,000.

Engage your mind through summer Sunday School, both as a student and as a teacher for our children. Some adult classes will continue to meet this summer and for those that will not, an open class engaging your questions will be available. Be cool, stay in school and/or help out by teaching our kids for a week or two as well.

Engage your soul through fellowship. The calendar is filling up with the Dessert Auction, the Lazy Five Ranch, youth trips, children's activities, the Tuesday Adult Lunch, and more, all leading up to Montreat in September. Our soul is who we are, and loving God with all our soul means sharing who we are with God and one another.

Engage your strength by contributing your talents, be it with the Habitat house, or any of our church committees. God has given each of us talents and strengths, which can be amplified in service to Christ's church. Volunteers are always needed, and we want your voice and your gifts leading this church.

At different stages of life, one or another may take the lead, or be all we can do. But this summer, **I pray you find your opportunity to grow in your walk with Jesus through the life of His church here at Shelby Presbyterian.**

SESSION MINUTES APRIL 18, 2023

Communications

Clerk's Report – No Report

Deacon's Report – Elizabeth Schweppe reported:

April 18th Blood Drive has been successful and is thankful for all the Deacons contributing their efforts to serve our church.

Pastor's Report – Drew reported:

- Funeral for Cheryl Sisk will be at 4:00 p.m. Saturday, April 22, 2023. Unanimous vote to approve worship service.
- The Emergency Assistance Fund is depleted, and Drew is hopeful that this Emergency Fund may be increased in amounts available. Session referred to Mission and Ministry to propose a plan and policy for the Emergency Assistance Fund to be forwarded to the Finance Committee for further recommendation to the session on fund availability.

Committee Reports:

- Revenue for March exceeded expenses by \$3,000.00.
- Van delivery is anticipated in the short term and the anonymous donor has also agreed to provide an enclosed trailer.
