Hi SPC!

With your unanimous selection of the Rev. Drew Mangione as your next installed pastor, my time as your interim pastor comes to an end this month. My last Sunday with you will be July 11th, and my last day in the church office will be July 15th.

It has been a great privilege for me to lead you through your interim/wilderness time to your Jordan River, and I will leave it to the Lord and Drew and Carol Ann and the rest of your church staff and elders and deacons to take you the rest of the way to your Promised Land. I am excited about your future. The Lord is doing a new thing among you, and I can't wait to find out with you exactly what it is.

Some of you have wondered where I am going from here. Well, on July 18th I will enjoy a week at the beach with my family in St. Augustine, Florida. Then, on July 25^{th,} I begin a six-week bridge interim at St. Charles Avenue Presbyterian Church in the Uptown section of New Orleans, near Audubon Park, which will take me to the end of August. That church needs six weeks of pastoral support until their new pastor, Chris Currie, can begin on September. 1st. The wonderful side benefit for me is that my youngest son, Sam, and his wife, Kelly, live within a mile of that church. We don't see a whole lot of each other these days, but suddenly we are going to have six glorious weeks in New Orleans together. The rest of the family is talking about all flying down for my last Sunday there.

Sam, as you may or may not know, is a church organist at John Calvin Presbyterian Church in the Metairie section of New Orleans, and teaches piano at home to 20 students. He continues to take organ lessons from the organist at the church I will serve in New Orleans. Kelly works as an administrative assistant in the Music Department at Loyola University and is earning two master's degrees, one in Music Therapy and one in Piano Performance, and is on track to receive both degrees next May. They are a very musical couple!

After my brief stint in New Orleans, pending approval of the Committee on Ministry of Foothills Presbytery, I will begin another interim assignment on September 1st at Central Presbyterian Church in Anderson, SC. My contract with them is for five months and then month to month after that until their new pastor begins. (With any luck that church assignment will last long enough to get me to 65, when I can enroll in Medicare!) Their current senior pastor, David Bailey, retires at the end of this month after 20 years with them. Sound familiar?

Drew begins his work with you on August 2nd and will preach his first sermon to you on August 8. Between my leaving and Drew's arrival, you will have three supply preachers filling the pulpit on Sundays: Rev. Richard Hart (July 18th), Rev. Maggie Lauterer (July 25th), and our new General Presbyter, Rev. Byron Wade (August 1st).

COVID turned my interim time with you into something very different than any of us had planned, but I will still leave with many fond memories of you and our conversations and our work together on behalf of the church. Thanks to so many of you for your hospitality toward me, your notes and gifts and words of affirmation. God bless you as you move into the future that the Lord has prepared for you.


CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR COLLEGE GRADUATE!

Dear Church Members,



SESSION MEETING NOTES MAY 18, 2021

Communications

• John Brotherton provided an update on the virtual Presbytery meeting on April 27 and an update on the status of streaming services from the sanctuary. A report and recommendation from the Reopening Task Force was presented, discussed, and approved lifted unanimously. The recommendation occupancy limits but requires adherence to current North Carolina executive orders addressing COVID restriction, and requests for various committees to plan for continuing to plan for implementing practices for collecting offering, traditional communion, and other aspects of our past standard worship.

• Greg Melton presented an update from the Coordinating Council recommendation on Committee realignment. Discussion was held and a vote to approve the recommendation was approved unanimously.

• David Garnett presented the following:

• Informed everyone of upcoming announcements of a Congregational Meeting on June 6th and the addition of Carol Ann Hoard to our staff.

• Announced the following will fill in the when David is away over the coming months: Carol Ann Hoard (6/13), Richard Hart (7/18), Maggie Lauterer (7/25), and our PWNC General Presbyter Rev. Byron Wade (8/1).

• A request from Elizabeth Schweppe to welcome Carol Ann Hoard on June 6th was presented. A motion to accept was made, discussion held, and was approved unanimously.

Committee Reports

• <u>Finance Committee</u> – Scoot Dixon provided an update on church finances, noting that both offerings and expenses remain below budget. An emphasis continues on overall stewardship.

• <u>Member Care</u> – Jessi Ogburn continued to stress the need to reach out to our neighborhood groups and reported positive feedback from our members.

• <u>Personnel Committee</u> – Martha Noblitt provided an update that Emily Monroe had accepted the role of Organist. Interviews are ongoing and the search continues for a bookkeeper.

• <u>Pastoral Nominating Committee (PNC)</u> – John Brotherton presented the official Terms of Call that included items previously approved by Session. Terms were approved officially by vote following the recommendation of the PNC. A request to show a video welcome statement from the new pastor following the vote during the congregational meeting was presented. Discussion followed and a vote to approve passed with a majority in favor of the presentation in the sanctuary.

• <u>Music and Worship</u> – Ben Brooks presented a recommendation from the committee that Nursery care be scheduled with appropriate staff. Recommendation was approved unanimously.
