A Prayer for Your Community

A Prayer for Your Neighbors

Father, you give every family in heaven and on earth its name. You made humans in your image and by your Word you shared in our life. Have mercy on my neighbors, even those most difficult, and by your Spirit, help me remember that what I do for them, I do for you. Amen.

A Prayer for Your Church

Jesus, you are the head of your church, and we are your body. I ask that you keep our church healthy, well nourished and strong. Help us to grow, praise and serve you by being welcoming and loving, true to your gospel and a part of your ministry of reconciliation. Amen.

A Prayer for Your Leaders

Holy Spirit, you are the source of all wisdom. Fill the leaders of my church, my community, my state, my nation and the world with your wisdom and be merciful to them.

Grant also that I might have your wisdom to discern when and where you call me to lead. Amen.

A Prayer of Confession

FORMS OF PRAYER

01

Petition

Our most common mode of prayer is to ask for God to intervene in some way either for ourself or for someone else.

02

Thanksgiving

It is important to give thanks to God when we pray, because this reminds us of our many blessings even amid struggle.

03

Confession

To 'confess' is to tell the truth, and so in prayers of confession we tell the truth about our sin and profess our beliefs.

04

Praise

When we praise God in our prayers, we are not just flattering God, but reminding ourselves of God's glory compared to us.

05

Lament

When things are not as they should be, it is important we tell God that we are angry or frustrated and stay connected.
